Playoff Rules:

All rules in place for the regular season will apply to playoff games, with the exception of the following:

1. A team must have at least 7 of its own players present by no later than 10 minutes after the scheduled start time or it will forfeit the game. No call-ups or borrowing of players from other teams permitted.
2. The higher seeded team is always the home team.
3. All games must have a winner. Extra innings will be played if needed to break a tie.
4. The official start time of a game may be adjusted if it is delayed due to weather or if an earlier game extends beyond curfew. The second game will play the full 1:40 from first pitch.

Reminder of rules that have been in question this season:

1. Pitchers are allowed 9 consecutive outs in any game.
2. Players may not pitch and catch in the same game.
3. Games are still no new inning after 1 hour and 40. If we are at 1:39 a new inning will be played!! If the outcome of the game is in doubt.
4. No open inning in the playoffs no matter what the score is.
